MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- Current enhanced security clearance (criminal reference check) for vulnerable populations administered by Canadian Police Information Centre (CPIC)
- 3-5 years clinical social work experience in an outpatient mental health setting
- In-depth knowledge of DSM-IV TR diagnostic criteria for psychiatric disorders most prevalent within the child and adolescent subpopulations
- Highly developed clinical skills in interviewing, psycho-social and risk assessment, treatment (individual, group and family therapy), crisis intervention and cognitive behavioural therapy with patients and families.
- Demonstrated knowledge of developmental stages of children-youth and within the family life cycle and the psychosocial issues that may occur in relation to this
- Demonstrated knowledge of Ontario Mental Health Act, Child and Family Services Act, Young Offenders Act (Canada), Health Care Consent Act, Powers of Attorney Act, Substitute Decisions Act, Personal Health Information Protection Act and other relevant legislation
- Extensive knowledge of evidence based practice and current experience in the assessment and treatment of complex mental health disorders in children-youth
- In-depth knowledge of community based and regional mental health and other relevant resources is essential
